Rules

1. By making a reservation or entering the property, guests acknowledge and agree to abide by all park rules, regulations, and policies.
2. **Check in Time: Noon 'til Sunset -- Check Out Time: 11:00 AM**
3. **All tenants and guests will be signing an accident waiver**
4. **Quiet Hours: 10:00 PM to 8:00 AM**
5. **Pet Policies:** Pets (no more than 3) must always be on a leash outside with adult supervision (no dog pens). Pick up after pet immediately. Dog Park will be open from 8:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. Pets are not allowed in the bathroom, office, laundromat.
6. Children need to be supervised.
7. Only one RV is allowed per site
8. Restrooms/showers/ and laundry are for guest only.
9. Speed Limit, 6 mph
10. No parking on road, parking is limited to designated spaces only
11. Respect your neighbors, their area, their property and park property
12. Do not walk through or cross other RV lots, please use roadways
13. NO Littering – This includes cigarette butts! Trash must be placed in designated dumpster promptly, not left out overnight.
14. Sewer hoses must have a secure seal, facilities of camper in working order, and tagged. During winter months, heated hoses are required.
15. No washing RVs or vehicles in the park
16. Non-RV storage is not allowed (including boats, non-running vehicles, utility trailers, etc.)
17. **No Fireworks or Firearms**
18. Please act responsibly. Illegal drugs, public drunkenness, disorderly conduct, and use of profane language will not be tolerated. Violation is grounds for your immediate eviction.
19. Please notify management immediately of any park utility issues.

We reserve the right to enter any campsite at any time. We reserve the right to refuse service or stay and to decline space of any site. We reserve the right to eject any guest or visitor without refund of site fee for: unpaid camp fees, violations of any rules/policies, and or damage to park property.

21. We are not responsible for physical or personal damages, injury, or loss by accident, weather-related damage, theft, or fire to RV or property, and/or person of any guest.
22. The registered guest is the “responsible party” and accountable for the actions of all family members and visitors.
23. Guest agree to comply with all park, federal, state, and local laws, health and safety regulations, and campground rules and regulations.
